GOVERNMENTS

A2 – Use the CONVENTIONAL NAME of a Government--- Unless the OFFICIAL NAME is in Common Use

Df. Government – the totality of corporate bodies (executive, legislative, & judicial) that exercises the powers of jurisdiction.

Df. Conventional Name – Geographic Name of the area over which the Government Exercises Jurisdiction

CORPORATE NAMES

GOVERNMENTS -- Establish ONLY the Heading for the Government:

Ex. USE: United States

NOT: The Executive Branch of the United States Government

Ex. USE: France

NOT: Republique francaise

CORPORATE NAMES

GOVERNMENTS -- Establish ONLY the Heading for the Government:

Ex. USE: Massachusetts

NOT: Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Ex. USE: Nottinghamshire (England)

NOT: County of Nottinghamshire

Ex. USE: Arlington (Mass.)

NOT: Town of Arlington

CORPORATE NAMES

GOVERNMENTS

If Do NOT Know if Body Exercising All Powers of Government:

1.) Establish Name as One of Agencies of Government – IF Name Sounds Like Agency Name of Govt.

2.) IF Name Does NOT Sound Like Agency Name of Govt., Establish ONLY the Heading for the Government

Enter DIRECTLY under its own Name and Make Cross Reference from Body in Form of SUBHEADING of the NAME of GOVERNMENT

- 1.) If Government Body Subordinate to Higher Body Entered Under its own Name, set up Subordinate according to TYPES 4 & (LCRI 24.12 & 14)
- 2.) If Subordinate Government Body Fits into Any of 11 TYPES of GOVERNMENT AGENCIES ENTERED SUBORDINATELY >>>>>>>>

CORPORATE NAMES

GOVERNMENT AGENCIES ENTERED SUBORDINATELY – TYPE 2:

ONLY TEST for TYPE 2: If Name Contains a Word that Normally Implies ADMINISTRATIVE SUBORDINATION— e.g. Committee, Commission, etc.--- which is dependent on whether Word is Used Commonly in a Particular Jurisdiction as Part of Names of Government Subdivisions

GOVERNMENT AGENCIES ENTERED SUBORDINATELY – TYPE 2:

USE JUDGMENT!!!

In Case of DOUBT, Consider the Word to NOT Imply ADMINISTRATIVE SUBORDINATION

2nd TEST Criterion for TYPE 2:

“ ... Provided that the Name of the Government is Required for the Identification of the Agency”

So– If Name of Government Stated Explicitly or Implied, Enter Independently

All Other Cases, Enter Subordinately

DIRECT REFERENCE From Name of Subordinate
Body -- Only if Name Appears Without Name of

Then ADD Name of Government to Reference:

- Proper nouns or adjectives
- Subject words
- Term "national" or "state" (or equivalents)
- Research Center
- Library
- Technical Laboratory

QUALIFIERS: If Body Entered Under Own Name (NOT Subordinately), ADD Name of Government as QUALIFIER Unless Already Present in Body's Name

Ex. 110 1 International Union for Conservation of Nature and Natural Resources. |b Commission on Education. |b North-West Europe Committee

Ex. 110 1 United States. |b Office of Education. |b Office of Librarians and Learning Resources

AVOID VERY LITERAL APPROACH!!

If Name of Subordinate Body Being Established IMPLIES Ideas Expressed in Higher Body's Name, Do NOT Repeat Words in that Name:

Ex. 110 1 Pennsylvania. |b Bureau of Financial Management (OMIT Higher Body: Office of Administration)

Ex. 110 1 United States. |b Division of Nuclear Power Development

(OMIT Higher Body: Dept. of Energy)

In Case of **DOUBT**, Retain Higher Body in Heading:

Ex. 110 1 United States. |b Dept. of Health, Education, and Welfare. |b Advisory Council on Vocational Education

REMEMBER!:

Make CROSS REFERENCE From Name of Subheading's Immediately Superior Body When you Eliminate Parts of the Full Hierarchy!

- SURNAMENES:

Generally, Do NOT Add Qualifier to Corporate Name that Contains 2 or More Surnames that Lack Forenames/Forename Initials

Ex. 110 2 Morgan & Morgan

Ex. 110 2 B. Morgan & D. Morgan (Firm)

BUT NOT: Morgan & Morgan (Firm)

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- PERFORMING DUETS, TRIOS

Do NOT Add Qualifier Whether Corporate Form Contains 2 or More Surnames or 2 or More Forenames

Ex. 110 2 Simon & Garfunkel

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- INITIALISMS & ACRONYMS

If Heading Written in All Capital Letters, Generally ADD a Qualifier ---

UNLESS 24.5C is Applicable ...

BUT Do NOT Qualify if Used as 4XX:

Ex. 110 2 CAST (Group)

BUT if 410 2 C.A.S.T. >>>> NO Qualifier!

NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

24.5C: Terms Indicating Incorporation ...

OMIT Terms or Abbreviations Indicating Incorporation or State Ownership of Corporate Body--- and a Word or Phrase Designating TYPE of Incorporated Entity UNLESS Integral Part of Name or Needed to Make Clear that Name is Corporate Body Name

NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

24.5C: Terms Indicating Incorporation ...

Ex. American Ethnological Society (Without: "Inc.")

Ex. Automobiltechnische Gesellschaft (Without: E.V.)

Ex. Daiwa Ginko (Without: "Kabushiki Kaisha")

Ex. Thuringisches Kunstfaserwerk "Wilhelm Pieck" (Without: "VEB")

Ex. Compania Internacional Editora (Without: "S.a.")

CORPORATE NAMES

LCRI 24.5C1 – Judging if Term of Incorporation is INTEGRAL to Name:

"If the adjectival term or terms indicating incorporation or state ownership of a commercial enterprise appears initially or medially in the name, it is ... an INTEGRAL PART of the NAME."

Question to Ask Oneself:

Is the Term of Incorporation necessary to Convey "Corporateness"?

CORPORATE NAMES

NAMES THAT DO NOT CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

24.5C: Terms Indicating Incorporation ...

BUT you Should Include the Term of Incorporation in the following examples:

- Ex. Films Incorporated (Integral part of name)
Ex. Nihon Genshiryoku Hatsuden Kabushiki Kaisha
Ex. Peter Davies Limited (Integral part of name)
Ex. Vickers (Aviation) Limited

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO NOT CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

24.5C2: If the Term of Incorporation Occurs at Beginning of Name but is Needed to Make it Clear that the Name is a Corporate Body, Transpose it to the END!!

Ex. 110 2 Elektrometall, Aktiebolaget
NOT: Aktiebolaget Elektrometall

Ex. 110 2 Hochbauprojektierung Karl- ~~Max~~ Stadt, VEB

24.4B NAMES THAT DO NOT CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

• SHIPS

ADD a General Designation as a QUALIFIER if Name of Ship Alone Does NOT Convey the Idea of a Corporate Body

General Designation = (Ship), (Steamship), etc. If Question>>>Take Term from Item being Cataloged

Ex. 110 2 Ulua (Ship)

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO NOT CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

• SHIPS

If More Than 1 Ship with Same Name, ADD General Designation as Specific as Necessary to Resolve Conflict

Ex. 110 2 Franklin (Aircraft carrier)
Ex. 110 2 Franklin (Steamship)

Ex. 110 2 Lexington (Aircraft carrier : CV6)
Ex. 110 2 Lexington (Aircraft carrier : CVA(N)65)

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO NOT CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

• SHIPS

OMIT Abbreviations Before Name of Ship, e.g. U.S.S., H.M.S., etc.

Ex. 110 2 Ark Royal (Ship)
NOT: H.M.S. Ark Royal

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO NOT CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY

• ART GALLERIES

If 24.5C NOT APPLICABLE and Art Gallery Needs General Designation Qualifier, Use Term (Gallery) as Qualifier Instead of More Specific Term

BUT: Do NOT Change Existing Headings in LC NAF Using (Art Gallery) Instead of (Gallery)

Also: Do NOT Use (Gallery) as Qualifier for Art Museum that Needs General Designation Qualifier

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- CONSULTANT FIRMS

If Name Consists Solely of Subject Words and the Word "Consultants" (or equivalent), ADD General Designation Qualifier to Name (Unless 24.5C Applicable)

BUT Do NOT ADD Qualifier if Name Contains Other Elements:

110 2 Hospital Maintenance Consultants (Firm)

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

MULTIPLE QUALIFIERS:

Case: Additional Qualifier Needed, ADD 1st Qualifier called for in rules and then ADD 2nd Separated by Space-Colon-Space

Ex. 110 2 Red Sea (Restaurant : Washington, D.C.)

Ex. 110 2 BANAS (Organization : Indonesia)

CORPORATE NAMES

PRE-1981 HEADINGS

Headings established prior to Jan. 1981 were coded "A2" (prior to Sept. 1982) if Fell Within Either of Two Categories:

1.) Heading Contained Qualifier NOT NEEDED according to current policy

Ex. 110 2 Chef's Rights Alliance (Society)
Under "A2" would be : Chef's Rights Alliance

CORPORATE NAMES

PRE-1981 HEADINGS

Headings established prior to Jan. 1981 were coded "A2" (prior to Sept. 1982) if Fell Within Either of Two Categories:

2.) Heading Lacked Qualifier that would be Needed according to current policy

Ex. 110 2 BFA Educational Media
Under "A2" would be : BFA Educational Media (Firm)

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- PERFORMING GROUPS

RULES TO APPLY:

Rule 1.) Do NOT ADD a General Designation to Name IF it Contains a Word that Specifically Designates a Performing Group or Corporate Body, e.g. Band, Society, etc.,

--OR-- IF it Contains a Collective or Plural Noun, e.g. Ramblers, Hot Seven, etc.

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- PERFORMING GROUPS

RULES TO APPLY:

Rule 2.) If Group's Name is Very Vague, e.g. Who, Circle, Jets, etc., --OR--

has the Appearance of a Personal Name, e.g. Jethro Tull, ADD GENERAL DESIGNATION to Group Name

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- PERFORMING GROUPS

RULES TO APPLY:

Rule 3.) If Name Falls Between Categories of Rule 1 & Rule 2, e.g. Led Zeppelin, Jefferson Airplane, etc.,
ADD General Designation to Group Name

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- PERFORMING GROUPS

RULES TO APPLY:

Rule 4.) In Case of DOUBT, ADD General Designation

Use Designation “(Musical Group)” Unless a CONFLICT Dictates Using a More Specific Term

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- SPORTS TEAMS

If Name Does NOT Explicitly Convey Fact it is a Sports Team, ADD Qualifier that Includes Term “(Team)” Following Name of Sport

Ex. 110 2 Miami Dolphins (Football Team)

Ex. 110 2 Chicago Black Hawks (Hockey Team)

CORPORATE NAMES

24.4B NAMES THAT DO **NOT** CONVEY IDEA OF CORPORATE BODY:

- SPORTS TEAMS

If Team is Associated with Institution, e.g. college team, make Cross Reference (4XX) from Name of Team as SubHeading of Institution

Ex. 110 2 Buckeyes (Football team)
