Use American FactFinder to locate data from the 2000 Census relevant to a specified street address.

1. Click on "Enter a street address." (figure 1)

2. Enter 2222 Main Street, Buffalo, NY in the search form, and click “Go.” (figure 2)

Census Tract 53, Erie County, New York

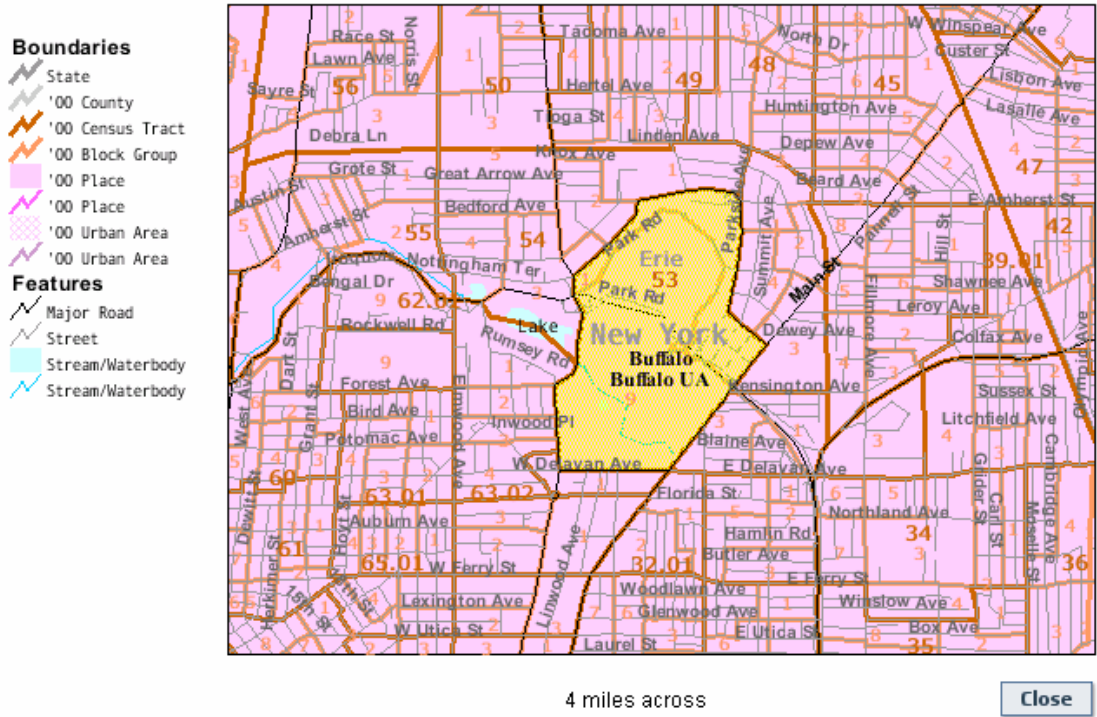
